

Suggestions for project summary for Arctic Competition 2018

When your student prepares his/her summary, you may be asked for various information. We are aware that at the first stage of the Competition you as a team submit a summary and not the full project, so your student will probably only be able to describe his/her ideas for the project. This is quite ok.

What should be included in the summary? Maybe you can get some ideas from this list:

- 1. Subject. Describe the subject of your project. What are you curious about in the Arctic?
- 2. Hypothesis. Suggest an hypothesis, why is it like this?
- 3. Plan. How do you plan to answer your hypothesis? Make a (research) plan to collect information.
- 4. Information. You will need information, how will you collect this information?
- 5. Results. If possible at this early stage you could say some words about how you plan to sum up your results?
- 6. Presentation. Do you have some ideas how you would like to present your results? For instance essay, poster or video.

You can use <u>the Curiosity-Method</u> as inspiration for the summary and especially for the whole project.
